Termly Learning Bulletin Bonsai Class

In English we will be:

Reading a range of stories including 'Pumpkin Soup', 'The Invisible', 'The Gingerbread Man', 'Standing up to Racism', and 'Celebrations Around the World'.

In Phonics we will be:

- Learning these sounds: f, ff, l, ll, ss, j, v, w, x, y, z, zz, qu, ch, sh, th(v), th, ng, oo, ar.
- The high frequency words are: he, she, me, we, be, of, if, off, you, my, they, for, will, all, went, was, from, help, too, her, with, are, yes, then, them, that, this, said.

In Maths we will be learning:

- To find one more of one less than numbers to 5.
- Exploring shapes including comparing and describing position.
- To be able to identify, subitise (recognise without counting) and represent 1-5.
- To begin to distinguish and talk about the difference between the key events in their daily routine.

This term we will be using our 'Favourite Five' books to support our learning, we will be learning about why we are important to celebrations that occur in the autumn and winter including Diwali, Remembrance Day and Christmas.

We will also be learning about:

- In PSHE we will learning to celebrate differences.
- In RE we will be exploring which people are special and why.
