In English, we will be:

- Reading *How to Live Forever*, *All Aboard the Empire Windrush* and *The Island* as part of our guided reading
- Writing Third-Person Narratives, Explanatory Texts and Autobiographies
- Writing Shakespearean Sonnets and Newspaper Reports
- Building on our learning of tenses and cohesion whilst using a wide range of conjunctions and adverbials to enrich our compositions

In Maths, we will be learning:

- How to use ratio language, factors and proportion in Ratio (Y6)
- How to use function machines, substitution, formulae and solve equations in Algebra (Y6)
- How to use our fraction knowledge to enhance our understanding of decimals and percentages (Y6)
- How to calculate the area, perimeter and volume of an array of shapes (Y5, Y6)
- How to use formal multiplication and division methods to solve calculations with increasingly larger numbers (Y5)
- How to use our knowledge of fractions with decimals and percentages (Y5)

In Science, we will be continuing to learn about animals (including humans) in biology as well as exploring light.

We will also be learning about:

- The Windrush Generation in history and Settlements in geography
- Exploring structures in DT and Printmaking in Art
- Discussing our goals and dreams in PSHE and exploring values and life-codes in Christianity and Humanism
