Termly Learning Bulletin Bonsai Class

In English we will be:

- Reading a range of stories including 'Clean Up!', 'Winnie-the-Pooh Helps the Bees', 'Bear Shaped', and 'William Bee's Wonderful World of Things That Go!'
- We will be learning how to write simple sentences with increasing independence.

In Phonics we will be:

- Learning these sounds: oi, ear, and ure. We will be applying our phonics knowledge to read and spell CVCC and CCVC words.
- The high frequency words are: day, away, play, children, your, here, time, out, house, about.

In Maths we will be learning:

- Build numbers to 20.
- Continue patterns beyond 10.
- Addition and Subtraction
- Manipulate, compose and decompose shapes.

This term we will be using our 'Favourite Five' books to support our learning, we will be learning about recycling everyday materials, how to care for our environment and animals, as well as learning about different modes of transport.

We will also be learning about:

- In PSHE we will be learning how to be a good friend as well as how to resolve problems.
- In RE we will be exploring 'what does it mean to belong to a faith?'
- Why bees are important and how we can help them.
